WALK YOUR WHEELS



WHAT DO WE MEAN WHEN WE SAY 'WALK YOUR WHEELS'?

It's simple: On busy sidewalks—like along Nine Mile Rd. and Woodward Ave.—we're asking cyclists to walk their bikes.

Removing riding from pedestrian sidewalks = improved safety for ALL. No swerving to avoid turning cars, dodging outdoor dining areas, or cyclist-walker collisions.

Cyclists on sidewalks are at least **TWICE** as unsafe as those riding on roadways—mainly because of blind conflicts at intersections and the unpredictability of pedestrians.
